## **Book Bank Policy**

## **Objectives:**

Book Bank Facility is aimed to motivate and support students from economically backward section, socially backward, and academic performers.

## **Guidelines:**

- 1. Under this policy, students shall be selected by Library Advisory Committee on the basis of following criteria
  - a. Economically Weaker Student
  - b. Socially Backward Students (SC/ST/NT/OBC)
  - c. Academic Performer
- 2. Selected students should be provided with one set of books (one book for each subject) for duration of one semester.
- 3. Student shall be responsible for any type of wear and tear of books. If the book is lost, the student has to replace new copy of a lost book.
- 4. All Books should be returned within two days after theory exam is over otherwise a fine of Rs 10.00 per day per book shall be charged.
- 5. No change of book shall be allowed in the middle of the semester.
- 6. Students form B. Pharmacy I<sup>st</sup> to IV<sup>th</sup> year course can apply to avail DBCOP Book Bank facility.
